## WMPO TICKET POLICY

**SAFEGUARD YOUR TICKETS | NO RE-ENTRY | NO RAINCHECK PRIVILEGES | NO REFUNDS OR EXCHANGES  
TOURNAMENT DATE AND TIME SUBJECT TO CHANGE | ALL RIGHTS RESERVED**

Ages 15 and younger are free into tournament grounds but only those 3 years and younger will be permitted into the hospitality venue without a credential. Each ticket is a revocable license allowing access to a PGA TOUR golf tournament (the "Tournament"). Lost, stolen or damaged tickets are not the responsibility of PGA TOUR Enterprises, LLC, PGA TOUR, Inc. (collectively, "TOUR") or the Tournament and will not be replaced. You acknowledge that COVID-19 is extremely contagious and that despite the measures the Tournament has implemented to help mitigate the risk of transmission, the elimination of risk of exposure and infection to COVID-19 is not currently possible. By entering onto the grounds of the Tournament using this ticket, you acknowledge and agree to the following for yourself and on behalf of any accompanying minor (who shall also be deemed to be "you" for purposes of the following): YOU ASSUME ALL RISK AND DANGER ARISING OUT OF YOUR ATTENDANCE INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, RISKS RELATED TO COVID-19, LOSS OF YOUR PERSONAL PROPERTY, INJURY, OR DEATH FROM A GOLF SHOT OR BY OTHER SPECTATORS OR PLAYERS, AND YOU HEREBY RELEASE TOUR, THE HOST ORGANIZATION, THE HOST SITE, TELEVISION BROADCASTERS, SPONSORS, VENDORS AND THEIR RESPECTIVE AFFILIATES, EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS, AND ALL VOLUNTEERS, PARTICIPATING PLAYERS AND CADDIES, FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITIES ARISING OUT OF SUCH LOSSES, INJURIES, ILLNESS OR DEATH. FURTHERMORE, IN NO EVENT SHALL TOUR BE LIABLE TO YOU FOR CONSEQUENTIAL, ECONOMIC, INCIDENTAL, INDIRECT, PUNITIVE, SPECIAL, OR THIRD-PARTY DAMAGES INCURRED, OR LOSS OF PROFITS, ARISING OUT OF, IN CONNECTION WITH, OR RELATED TO THIS AGREEMENT, EVEN IF TOUR HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE LIKELIHOOD OR POSSIBILITY SUCH DAMAGES MAY BE INCURRED. You authorize TOUR and its affiliates and licensees to use your image, likeness, voice, actions and statements (and that of any minor you accompany) captured or made at the Tournament in any live or recorded telecast, transmission, reproduction, recording or photograph of the Tournament in any and all media now known or hereafter developed (in whole or in part) and for advertising, marketing, promotional, analytics and internal purposes, without payment of any compensation to you. You may only capture any account, description, video, audio, photographs, scoring-related data or statistic ("Content") of, from or at the Tournament on any day of the Tournament throughout the Tournament site (including, for clarity, competition areas on competition days), consistent with all posted rules and instructions of TOUR and/or Tournament staff. However, you may not capture, transmit, distribute, or otherwise use Content for any purpose other than personal, non-commercial purposes (e.g., for your personal social media accounts), and you may not distribute such Content on a live or near-live basis (no live streaming) or use such Content to create a real-time, stroke-by-stroke or hole-by-hole account of the Tournament. Further, you shall not use or authorize others to use any such Content for any commercial or promotional purpose, or for or in connection with a media outlet (directly or indirectly) unless you and the media outlet have received an official media credential for the Tournament from TOUR. TOUR is the sole owner of, and you hereby assign to TOUR, all right, title and interest in and to all Content, including all copyrights and rights to use all Content (including rights to use your social media posts incorporating the Content), subject to your permission from TOUR to capture and distribute certain Content on the limited terms set forth in this license. Upon reasonable request by TOUR, at TOUR's cost and expense, you will sign any documents necessary to effect TOUR's ownership and use of all Content. You shall not engage in any activity at the Tournament that creates a commercial association between a third party and TOUR or the Tournament, including without limitation, using, wearing, distributing or selling any promotional or commercial item at the Tournament or promoting or drawing attention to any business, cause or concern at the Tournament, in each case without permission from TOUR. For security purposes, you consent to the reasonable inspection of your person and property before entering the Tournament, which may include metal detection, and you waive all claims against TOUR arising out of such inspection. No standalone photo or video cameras (outside of mobile devices) on competition days (allowed practice days only), coolers, ladders, signs, firearms, explosive devices, etc. will be permitted onto the Tournament grounds. Mobile devices are permitted to the extent they are on silent and used in accordance with this license and the Mobile Device Policy posted on Tournament grounds and at [pgatour.com](http://pgatour.com). No alcoholic beverages may be brought onto or taken from the Tournament grounds. Any misconduct, illegal activity, intoxication, use of illegal substance, breaches of etiquette, disruptive behavior, heckling, or violation of any rule or instruction of Tournament representatives or violation of this license is prohibited and shall be grounds for forfeiture of your ticket and for your removal from the premises. You shall not seek autographs of players in order to sell such autographs, and you shall not pay another person to obtain an autograph for you. Tickets cannot be resold or otherwise used in a promotion, offered as a prize or reward in a sweepstake or otherwise, or used in a travel or hospitality package (e.g., combining tickets with flights and/or accommodations) without permission from TOUR. It is unlawful to reproduce tickets. Host organization and TOUR reserve the right to revoke any ticket and cancel all privileges connected therein. Use of any parking site provided for Tournament attendees is entirely at the risk of the vehicle driver and/or owner. Please take appropriate security precautions and lock your vehicle.

Further, if you have been issued credentials to access the Tournament by TOUR or the Tournament host organization and you are a Covered Person (as defined below), you are subject to the PGA TOUR Integrity Program (the "Integrity Program"). A "Covered Person" means (i) each person affiliated with a PGA TOUR player, including each caddie, family member, spouse, partner, agent, manager, instructor and trainer, (ii) each employee of the Tournament host organization, and (iii) each third party involved in the operation of the competition portion of the Tournament. The terms of the Integrity Program are set forth in the PGA TOUR Integrity Program Manual, which is available here. The Integrity Program, among other things: prohibits each Covered Person from betting on any aspect of the Tournament and providing inside information to third parties for betting on any aspect of the Tournament; and requires each Covered Person to report any violation of the Integrity Program to TOUR. A violation of the Integrity Program by a Covered Person may result in the revocation of his or her credentials to access the Tournament and other PGA TOUR events, among other consequences.

## FAN CODE OF CONDUCT

We take pride in the fact that the WM Phoenix Open has become one of the premiere sporting events in the country, attracting record-numbers of fans from throughout the United States and the world.

***Disruptive Fan behavior will not be tolerated at the WM Phoenix Open. Those engaging in violations of the Fan Code of Conduct are subject to immediate ejection and potential criminal trespass.***

To ensure a fun, safe and memorable experience for all, please adhere to the tournament's Code of Conduct

- Fans will respect the Tournament Players, Caddies, Officials and other fans.
- Fans will enjoy the WM Phoenix Open free from disruptive behavior including, but not limited to – FOUL OR ABUSIVE LANGUAGE, obscene gestures, fighting, throwing objects, attempting to disrupt play or distract Tournament Players from their professional game. Such behavior includes taunting players, caddies and officials, volunteers or other fans. Those who engage in any of these actions are subject to immediate ejection from the Tournament and subject to criminal trespass.
- Fans will avoid engaging in behavior that endangers the safety of Tournament Players, caddies, officials, volunteers or other spectators.
- Fans consuming alcoholic beverages will do so in a responsible manner. Impaired, or intoxicated fans will be removed from the tournament grounds and subject to criminal trespass or prosecution.
- Underage fans who are found to be consuming alcoholic beverages or any fan who assists in purchasing or supplying alcoholic beverages to underage fans will be removed from the tournament grounds in a prompt and safe manner and subject to criminal prosecution.
- Tournament volunteers, ambassadors, security and police personnel are trained to intervene where necessary to help ensure that the above expectations are met, and fans are encouraged to report any inappropriate behavior to the nearest tournament representative.
- The Thunderbirds reserve the right to deny entry or eject from the tournament fans displaying inappropriate behavior.
- Fans who choose not to adhere to any of these provisions will be subject to ejection without refund. Hospitality Package holders and/or their guests who are identified violating any of these provisions are subject to revocation of their hospitality suite, box and/or package for the remainder of the tournament and all future tournaments.





## 2025 SECURITY PROCEDURES

The WM Phoenix Open and the PGA TOUR are committed to providing the safest experience for both players and fans. Fans should be respectful to the players and courteous to fellow patrons. Those displaying egregious behavior will be removed from the tournament immediately.

Tournament officials are working hard in advance of the upcoming tournament to ensure the enhanced security procedures are implemented seamlessly and that the public is aware of them prior to arriving at the main tournament entrance. Much of the TOUR's security policy will be implemented behind the scenes and will have virtually no impact on your experience as a spectator. So, as you begin to plan for the upcoming WMPO please take the following procedures into account. We've highlighted the key elements of the security policy below.

### BAG INSPECTION

---

- Bag inspection will be performed at all Admission Gates while gates are open.
- Opaque bags, including purses, are not to exceed 6"x 6" in their natural state. Guests will not be allowed to empty and collapse a non-approved bag into a clear bag.
- Clear plastic, vinyl, or other carry items not exceeding 12"x 6"x 12".
- Volunteers bringing additional items to their assigned shifts must use a clear bag that does not exceed 12"x 6"x 12". All volunteers will pass through a security checkpoint prior to entering the golf course.

### METAL DETECTION

---

- Everyone attending the tournament is subject to search at the entrances and on the course at any time.
- Walk-through metal detectors will be used at each entrance gate for everyone including volunteers, spectators, working staff, media, etc.

## UPDATED PGA TOUR AUTOGRAPH POLICY

- Autographs can only be obtained at designated Autograph Zones.
- On-course autographs are not permitted. This includes, but is not limited to, tees, fairways, greens and practice areas during practice rounds and tournament rounds.
- No memorabilia can be brought into the tournament including pin flags, photos, trading cards, balls and other sports paraphernalia.

## PERMITTED ITEMS

- Personal bags 6" x 6" or smaller
- Clear plastic, vinyl or other carry items not exceeding 12" x 6" x 12"
- A one-gallon clear resealable plastic bag
- Reusable plastic or metal cups/bottles that are empty upon entry and exit, and cannot hold more than 32-ounces
- Mobile phones, tablets, and PDA's - MUST be on Silent mode and adhere to TOUR's Mobile Device Policy
- Point and shoot, film or DSLR cameras with lens smaller than 6"; no case (During Practice Rounds Only)
- Umbrellas without sleeve
- Portable radios with headsets
- Medically necessary materials, strollers, small diaper bags, plastic baby bottles, and other essential baby supplies (infant must be with carrier) - items subject to search
- Collapsible chairs without chair bags
- Binoculars without case
- Seat cushions that do not require a carrying case or that do not have pockets or compartments
- Segways®, motorized scooters or other personal transportation devices when used as a mobility aid by individuals with mobility impairment








## **SPECTATOR MOBILE DEVICE POLICY FOR PGA TOUR TOURNAMENTS**

Revised November 12, 2021

- Devices must be on silent at all times; flash may not be used.
- Devices may be used to capture video, audio and photos (content) in all areas throughout tournament week
- Content may not be used for commercial purposes, only personal use (e.g., personal social media)
- No live streaming or real-time coverage (e.g., no shot-by-shot coverage)
- Please be respectful of play and do not interfere with players, caddies or media
- All posted signage and instructions from tournament staff must be observed
- Failure to comply with this policy may result in the revocation of your ticket
- Please see below for the complete terms of the Spectator Mobile Device Policy
