CHARITIES

The Waste Management Phoenix Open and the tournament host Thunderbirds raise money for charities, most of which provide programs that benefit youth. Recent beneficiaries include Phoenix Children's Hospital, First Tee of Phoenix, Special Olympics Arizona, Homeward Bound, Boys & Girls Clubs, YMCA, Waste Not, Junior Golf Association of Arizona, Elevate Phoenix, A New Leaf and Tumbleweed. The 2016 Waste Management Phoenix Open raised more than \$9.3 million dollars for charity, setting a tournament record, and The Thunderbirds have raised more than \$111 million in the tournament's 81-year history.

TICKETS

Daily general admission is FREE on Monday and Tuesday thanks to Ford Free Days, and \$40 Wednesday through Sunday. Children ages 17 & under are free when accompanied by an adult. The Waste Management Phoenix Open is never sold out and tickets will be available at the gate during tournament week. Advance daily general admission tickets will be available until Friday, Jan. 27, 2017, at all Ticketmaster ticket centers, by phone at (800) 745-3000 and online via www.wmphoenixopen.com or www.ticketmaster.com.

PARKING

FREE Public Parking (with shuttle access to the tournament gates). From the WEST, public parking is at Loop 101 and Hayden Road. We recommend that eastbound Loop 101 drivers exit at Hayden, and drive south into the parking lot. From the EAST, parking is at WestWorld. We recommend that drivers exit Raintree, then drive north to Bell Road on 94th street, then into the parking lot entrance. The FREE shuttles will operate Monday and Tuesday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.; Wednesday through Saturday from 6:30 a.m. to 11 p.m.; and Sunday from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
