CHARITIES

The WM Phoenix Open and the tournament host Thunderbirds raise money for Arizona charities, most of which provide programs that benefit youth. Recent beneficiaries include First Tee of Phoenix, Fresh Start Woman's Foundation, Human Services Campus, Special Olympics Arizona, and Valley Youth Theatre. The 2022 WM Phoenix Open raised nearly \$10.5 million for charity and The Thunderbirds have raised more than \$176 million in the tournament's 87-year history.

TICKETS

Daily general admission is FREE on Monday and Tuesday thanks to Ford Free Days, \$50 Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday, and \$75 Friday and Saturday. Children ages 15 & under are free when accompanied by an adult. The WM Phoenix Open is never sold out and tickets will be available at the gate during tournament week. Advance daily general admission tickets will be available until Friday, Feb. 3, 2023, at all Ticketmaster ticket centers, by phone at (800) 745-3000 and online via www.wmphenixopen.com or www.ticketmaster.com.

PARKING

General Public Parking (with shuttle access to the tournament gates) is **FREE** and available in the following areas:

WESTWORLD (Lot W)

We recommend drivers exit coming from the East on the Loop 101 exit on Frank Lloyd Wright Blvd., then drive north to Bell Road to 94th street, then into the parking lot entrance. Coming from the West on Loop 101 take the Bell Road exit. The FREE shuttles from Lot W will operate **Wednesday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m.**, and on **Sunday from 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.**

HAYDEN/MAYO (Lot H – LIMITED PARKING)

We recommend Loop 101 drivers exit at Hayden and drive south into the parking lot. The FREE shuttles from Lot H will operate **Monday and Tuesday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.**; **Wednesday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m.**; and **Sunday from 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.**

SALT RIVER FIELDS (SRF)

Free parking is also available at Salt River Fields at Talking Stick at the Loop 101 and Via de Ventura. Shuttles to and from the tournament entrance are available at this location as well and will run **Thursday – Sunday only, from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.**

Ride Share pick up is now located at the WestWorld location as well.
